Extinguisher Use & Inspection

- Chemicals present - Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS)
- Fire extinguisher inspection & maintenance, security, pressure gauge, hose, nozzle, tag

Fire Prevention & Protection

- Typical sources of fires, housekeeping, flammable materials, storage, electrical, HVAC materials, personal smoking
